

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

AMH Anchorage Cup Sven Johansson

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Sunday, February 22

Noon, 30K

12:30 P.M., 10K

Skate, Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Possible snow or rain on Thursday. Friday high in the 20s. Saturday, partly cloudy, high in the 20s. Saturday night lows 5 to 15. Sunday high in the 20s. New snow will be mixed with old dry transformed snow. Course will probably be dirty.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. If no new snow has fallen then HF Moly should be applied instead of HF Red. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. If there is rain, use one pass with coarse non linear wheel of TOKO structurite tool.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
