

WAX RECOMMENDATION



AMH Anchorage Cup Pia's Classic

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Sunday, February 8

Classic

Noon, 30K; 12:20 P.M., 15K; 12:30 P.M., 5K

Wave start

30K, 4 loops; 15K, 2 loops; 5K, 1 loop

Forecast/Conditions: Thursday through Saturday night chance of snow, Saturday night low 5F to 15F. Sunday, mostly cloudy, chance of snow, high 15 to 25. Expect old snow mixed with new snow in the forecast. Good tracks.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 100 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth. Check in the bunker at the TOKO easel for updated kick wax. Expect abrasive snow. Look for Patrick near the feed station for kick wax touch up during 15K and 30K.

Structure: A cold universal grind will be best for these conditions. Higher temp and new snow may require additional structure be added with a TOKO Structurite. Check in the bunker at the TOKO tables before the race.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
