

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Cushman Street Bridge downtown, Fairbanks, AK

Saturday, March 14

20K/50K Skate

Mass start

1 lap for both races

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night -5F with a high of 15 Saturday. Chance of snow with high in the upper teens and low around 0. The 20K is all on snowmachine-packed river trail, and the middle 30 kilometers of the 50K are on well-groomed ski trails. The 10K on the Chena River usually has dirty snow, especially around the bridges.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Then apply HF Blue, sprinkle on Nordlite Powder X-cold, iron in together, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure or universal structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
