

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **HS Region IV Championships**

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Saturday, February 21

11 A.M., Mass start

Classic Relay

Boys 4 X 5K, Girls 4 X 3.5K

Boys Open 5K, Girls Open 3.5K

Forecast/Conditions: Friday, mostly cloudy with a chance of snow showers. Friday night, partly cloudy, lows in the teens. New snow will be mixed with dry transformed snow. Course will be dirty.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 120 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon Klister Base Green, very thin. Check with TOKO for updated grip wax recommendation.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. If rain, one pass with coarse non linear wheel of TOKO structurite tool.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.**
