

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

15K/7.5K/2.5K Freestyle

Wave start

15K 2 loops, 7.5K 1 loop

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night low in the teens. Saturday and Saturday night highs in the 20s, lows in the teens. Thin, old, transformed snow (coarse and abrasive). Expect some dirt on hills. No new snow in forecast.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N / A

Structure: A cold universal grind covered by one pass with the Blue TOKO Structurite tool (old fine-linear wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
