

WAX RECOMMENDATION



High School Lynx Loppett Freestyle

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Saturday, Dec. 12

10:30 A.M.

7.5K Boys varsity, all others 5K

Pursuit (top 100 skiers in each category)

1 Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Friday high 15 to 25. Friday night low in the teens. Thin, old, transformed snow (coarse and abrasive). Expect some dirt on hills. No new snow in forecast.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Blue mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A cold universal grind covered by one pass with the Blue TOKO Structurite tool (old fine-linear wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
