

WAX RECOMMENDATION



ASD HS Region IV Championships

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Friday, February 19

Noon

Skate

Boys 10.8K; Girls 8K; Open 4.7K

Interval Start, 2 Skiers @ 30 seconds

1 Lap Per Racer

Forecast/Conditions: Thursday night possible rain and snow. Low in the mid-20s to mid-30s. Friday cloudy with scattered rain and snow showers. High around 40. Snow has deteriorated with high temperature and rain. Expect dirty and wet conditions.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow/HF Moly mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red/JetStream Yellow mixed 1:1, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A warm universal grind covered by one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions. If new snow is on the course use the Yellow TOKO Structurite tool.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
