

WAX RECOMMENDATION



AMH Anchorage Cup Pia's Classic

Kincaid Park Anchorage, AK

Sunday January 27

15K Classic or 30K Classic

Race Start 12PM

Mass Start, Multi Loops

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday**...Snow showers likely. Highs in the upper teens to mid 20s. **Friday Night**...Mostly clear. Lows 5 to 15 above. **Saturday And Saturday Night**...Mostly clear. Highs in the mid teens to lower 20s. Lows 5 below to 5 above. **Sunday**...Partly cloudy. Highs in the teens.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly(if not glazing, use JetStream HighSpeed if glazing), brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Binder. See Toko Bunker for current information.

Structure: A cold universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
