

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Alpenglow Freestyle 20K

Tahoe Cross Country, Tahoe City, CA

Sunday, February 1

10 A.M.

20K/5K Skate

Wave start

1 Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night lows in the low 20s, Sunday highs in the low 40s and sunny, 36 degrees at start. Snow conditions: Tilled granular in the open and fine snow in the shade. The 20K loop features a long, shaded climb at mid-distance.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. Old JetStream High Speed is a suitable fluoro alternative.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A medium flex ski with universal grind structured with two passes of the Structurite fine non-linear wheel (before JetStream application) will best suit the course's varied conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
