

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Bjornloppet Race/Festival

Bear Valley Cross Country, Bear Valley, CA

Saturday, March 7

10:30 A.M.

20K/10K Skate

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday low of 20, high of 31; 30 percent chance of snow showers. Saturday morning low of 22, race start 29, high of 36; partly cloudy. Race course alternates between wide open meadow and trees. Look for some suction on sunny spots.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush thoroughly. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, then brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a Thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: Choose a medium ski with a linear grind and add one pass with the Coarse Offset wheel of a Toko Structurite tool (before JetStream application).

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
