

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Bjornloppet Classic Race**

Bear Valley Cross Country, Bear Valley, CA

Sunday, March 8

10 A.M.

10K Classic

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday low of 22, high of 36; partly cloudy. Sunday low of 25, race start 30, high of 34. Chance of snow is 20 percent. Race course is mostly on open, exposed, terrain with few uphill.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush thoroughly. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, then brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a Thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-4 layers of Carbon GripWax Red, corking between layers. Cover with Carbon Viola for better glide or add a light layer of Carbon Yellow for more kick.

Structure: Choose a soft-medium flex ski with a light grind and add one pass with the Coarse Linear Wheel of a Toko Structurite tool (before JetStream application).

For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.**
