

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **ASC Freestyle Sprint JOQ**

Auburn Ski Club Training Center, Donner Summit, CA

Sunday, February 15

1K Skate

10 A.M. Qualifiers

Noon Heats

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday low of 5F, high of 25, with an 80 to 100 percent chance of snow. Breezy. Sunday low of 20, race start 25, high of 28, with a 100 percent chance of snow. The new snow has been skiing colder and more abrasive than air temps would suggest.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: Choose a soft ski with a fine grind. Add one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application).

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
