

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Allan Bard Memorial and JOQ Classic

Tamarack XC, Mammoth Lakes, CA

Sunday, February 8

10 A.M.

5K/10K/20K Classic

Wave start

5K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday low of 23, high of 36 with a 40 percent chance of snow showers. Sunday low of 23, race start temp of 32, high of 36 with a 20 percent chance of snow. New snow expected late in the week and through weekend. High elevation makes for great skiing conditions.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or the older JS High Speed, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Cork in three+ layers of Carbon GripWax Red, corking between layers.

Structure: Choose a soft ski with a fine grind. Adding one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
