

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Glacier Point Skate Race

Badger Pass, CA

Sunday, February 22

9 A.M.

36K Skate

Out and back, Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high of 43, 30 percent chance of rain/snow mix. Sunday morning low of 24, race start temp 32. High of 40, cloudy, chance of snow. Out and back on gentle grades and very little flat.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a Thermopad. Helx Yellow would be a good alternative topcoat.

Structure: Choose a soft ski with a fine grind. Add one pass with the coarse-linear wheel of a Toko Structurite tool (before JetStream application).

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
