

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Paco's Fun Race

Auburn Ski Club , Soda Springs, CA

Sunday, December 21

10 A.M.

5km and 10km Freestyle

Interval Start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high of 25F. Saturday night, low of 2F, light winds and 20 percent chance of snow. Sunday, low of 2F, race start 20F, with a high of 27F. Snow expected just before race start. 2 Laps. Cold new snow expected all week, therefore, soft track, with cold and abrasive snow.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. Then apply HF Red, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper .
Iron in Carbon Base Wax Green and let cool. Cover with 3 thin layers of Carbon Gripwax Blue, add a thicker layer under foot only. If warmer, use Carbon Gripwax Viola covered with a thin layer of Blue. Cork between applying layers.

Structure: As little structure as possible on soft or medium flex skis.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
