

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## ASC Junior Freestyle JOQ

Auburn Ski Club, Soda Springs, CA

Sunday, January 18

10 A.M.

5K/10K/15K Skate

Interval Start

1-3 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high of 43, low of 20, east winds. Sunday low of 22, race start 32, with a high of 43, east winds. Old transformed snow that is cold and abrasive early, then softening. The east winds and north exposure make ASC colder than temperatures dictate. Wax, and dress, accordingly.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush. Then apply HF Red/HF Blue mixed 2:1, scrape and brush out well. Topcoats are not advised for JOQs.

Structure: Choose Medium Flex Ski with Universal Grind and add one pass with fine non-linear Toko Structurite Tool.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
