

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Sierra Skogsloppet

Tahoe Donner XC Center, Truckee, CA

Monday, January 19

10 A.M.

7.5K/15K Skate

Wave start

1/2 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Sunday high of 43, low of 20, east winds. Monday low of 20, race start 35, with a high of 45, light winds. Old transformed snow that is cold and abrasive early, then softening. The snow is staying colder than air temperatures dictate, especially early on. The snow is not particularly dirty.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush. (LF Blue is chosen over LF Moly because of the cold, abrasive snow early on). Then apply HF Red/HF Blue mixed 2:1, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, or old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and buff with a thermopad.

Structure: Choose Medium Flex Ski with Universal Grind and add one pass with fine non-linear Toko Structurite Tool.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
