

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Snowshoe Thompson Classic and JOQ

Auburn Ski Club, Truckee, CA

Sunday, December 27

10 A.M.

5K/10K Classic

Interval Start

5K Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high of 30 with overnight low of 15. Mostly cloudy. Race time temperature of 24 with Sunday high of 32. Cloudy, 20 percent chance of snow showers. Breezy, wind from the east, keeping things cooler than temperature would indicate.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, heat in a thin layer of Carbon Gripwax Green, smooth, and let cool. Then cork in 3-4 layers of Carbon Gripwax Viola or Red, smoothing after each layer. Wax a longer pocket for wind blown tracks.

Structure: A Soft to Medium Flex Ski with fine linear grind covered by one light pass with the BlueTOKO Structurite tool (old fine linear wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
