

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Glacier Point Skate Race

Badger Pass, Yosemite National Park, CA

Sunday, February 21

9 A.M.

36K (10K Juniors) Skate

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high in low 40s with overnight low of 14. Afternoon snow showers. Sunday at 9 A.M. expect 16 degrees with Sunday high of 34. Light snow showers expected. Expect soft snow on top of firm packed trails.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow (or old Jetstream Moly), brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A Medium flexed ski with fine linear grind covered by one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
