

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Yosemite Nordic Holiday Race

Badger Pass, Yosemite National Park, CA

Saturday, February 20

10:30 A.M.

10K/17K Classic only

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday high of 41 with overnight low of 18. Evening snow showers. Saturday at 10 A.M., temperature of 14, Saturday high of 36. Periods of light snow. Expect light dusting on tracks over firm packed trails.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/Yellow mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow (or old JetStream Moly), brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Apply Carbon Klister Base Green, let cool. Then cover with Klister MultiVoila. Add a short section of Klister Orange under foot for more kick.

Structure: A Medium flexed ski with fine linear grind covered by one light pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
