

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Lake Basin 15K

Tamarack Lodge XC, near Mammoth Lakes, CA

Sunday, January 10

10 A.M.

5K/15K Skate

Mass Start

5K lap

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday high of 41 with overnight low of 13. A 10 percent chance of snow. Sunday race time temperature of 25 with high of 40 and a 10 percent chance of snow. Race starts at Pack Station. Expect firm conditions, softening later in the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, and then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red or old JetStream Moly, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A.

Structure: A medium flexed ski with fine linear grind covered by a single pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
