

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Paco's Race and Jr National Qualifier

Auburn Ski Club, Soda Springs, CA

Sunday December 23

10K and 5K skate

Race Start 10AM

Multi-lap, Interval Start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday temps in the mid 30sF, partly cloudy. Saturday night low of 17F with a 20% chance of snow showers. Sunday temps in the mid 30sF. Race start temp 25F. Sunday High of 35-40F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Blue, mixed 2:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, buff with a thermopad. HelX Warm would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine offset structure on a medium flexing ski will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
