

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Paco's XC President's Cup

Tahoe Donner Cross Country Center, Truckee, CA

Monday February 18

15K Adults, 7K Juniors

Race Start 10AM

Mass Start, Single Loop, Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Sunday high 45-50F. Low of 20-25F.

Sunny. Monday low 20F, race start 28F, high 45F. Cloudy with 20% chance of Rain. The first half of this course is mostly downhill on the north side and through the trees.

Don't wax too warm.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow, mixed 2:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HeIX Warm would make an excellent alternative to JetStream in this case.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal structure on a medium stiff ski will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
