

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Yosemite Nordic Holiday Classic

Badger Pass Ski Area, Yosemite National Park, CA

Saturday February 23

16K Classic, Jr's 10K Classic

Race Start 10:30AM

Forecast/Conditions: Friday: 50% chance of snow, high 31 F. Friday night: 20 percent chance of snow. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 20 F. Saturday: Snow showers likely. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 34. Race temp.: mid to upper 20s F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream HighSpeed, brushing with a dedicated nylon brush, and polishing with a Thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone, and iron in Toko Base Green. Cover with Toko Gripwax Viola. Consult local TOKO athletes at start area for current recommendations.

Structure: A universal structure, covered by one pass with the fine offset wheel of a TOKO structurerite tool.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
