

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Bjornloppet Classic Race**

Bear Valley Cross Country Centre

Bear Valley, California

Sunday March 9

10km Classic

10am Start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday: Low of 30F, high of 43F, partly cloudy. Sunday: Low of 32F, race start upper 30s F, high in low 40sF with 20% chance of rain/snow showers. Inside Info: fairly flat course in open meadow, one long gradual uphill and couple of short little ones.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/Yellow, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by applying HeIX Warm, allowing to dry, and polishing well with the white side of a dual pad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in TOKO base Green Klister Binder. Cover with TOKO Klister Orange/Silver, mixed 1:1 applied THIN, covered with Carbon Yellow if it is snowing.

Structure: One pass each with the Toko Coarse Linear and Non Linear Structurite Tool will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
