

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Tom's 10K Classic

2X5K Lap

Forecast/Conditions: Chance of rain/snow today and then transformed snow that is fairly dirty. Forecast: Saturday Low 32F. Saturday High 46F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Yellow, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad. HelX Warm would make an excellent alternative.

Gripwax: Iron in TOKO base green klister to a roughened kick zone, allow to cool and cover with a very thin application of Orange/Silver Klister, mixed 2:1.

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the coarse-broken linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool, (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
