

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Howleson Hill Classic

Howleson Hill, Steamboat Springs, CO

Saturday, December 20

10K Classic

Race Start 9 A.M.

30-second interval start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday, cloudy with snow, high near 25F.

Friday night, snow likely, cloudy with a low near 4F.

Saturday, cloudy with a 50 percent chance of snow. High temperature 15-20F.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/Nordlite X-cold Powder ironed together, scrape and brush well. Finish by rotocorking in JetStream Blue, polish with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and buff with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Sand Kick area with 150 grit sandpaper, then iron in one layer of Carbon Base Wax Green and let cool. Cork in 2-3 layers of Carbon Gripwax Mint. Later racers may want to go with Carbon Gripwax White as temperatures increase.

Structure: A fine to a fine-linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
