

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Snow Mountain Ranch Stampede

UPDATED: Note start times and wax changes.

Snow Mountain Ranch, Granby, CO

Saturday, March 6

9:30 A.M. 21K/42K Classic

10 A.M. 42K Skate

10:30 A.M. 21K/10K Skate

Mass Start

21K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Chance of snow Friday with an overnight low of 14, high of 46 and partly cloudy skies. Air temperature will be 29 at the 9:30 A.M. start warming to 41 by noon.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, apply a very thin layer of Carbon Klister Base Green, iron in, let cool. Then apply a thin layer of Klister Multiviola, let cool well. Cover with either 2 very thin layers of Carbon GripWax Blue or Viola, cork very gently between layers. 21K racers could substitute with Carbon BaseWax Green and Carbon Basewax Silver or Yellow.

Structure: Medium grind - Boulder Nordic Sports Q0.3 or Q1.3 or one good pass with the Toko Structurite tool with the Red bit before applying the JetStream is recommended.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
