

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## **Snow Mountain Ranch Classic**

Snow Mountain Ranch, Granby, CO

Saturday, January 9

10 A.M.

7K/15K Classic

Mass start

7.5K loop, best line

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low of -5F, 10F at start. Partly cloudy and zero chance of precipitation. Snow will be transformed but dry and abrasive

**Glidewax:** First apply LF Blue/LF Moly mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Next, drip HF Blue on the ski, shake Nordlite Powder X-cold on top at about a 1:1 mix and iron them together, scrape and brush out well with a copper brush and then horsehair. Finish by applying JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 4-5 layers of Carbon GripWax Mint, corking between layers. For more kick, add in layers of Carbon Blue.

**Structure:** Fine grind - Boulder Nordic Sports ZR1 or CVO grind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
