

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Salomon Ranch Creek Opener

Devils Thumb Ranch, CO

Saturday December 15

15K Skate/ 15K Classic (Points for Skate Only)

Race Start 10AM

Colorado Cup #2

Forecast/Conditions: 50% chance of snow on Friday, possible 2-3 inches accumulation. Clearing overnight and becoming cold. Overnight lows around -10F. Partly cloudy Saturday. Expected race temps around 10-15F with fresh snow. Probable soft track conditions.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue/X-Cold Powder, mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Polish well with a horsehair brush, and then again immediately prior to start.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in a thin layer of TOKO Basewax Green. Follow by applying 2-3 layers of TOKO Carbon Mint.

Structure: A fine stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
