

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## Governor's Cup Tour, Keep Winter White Tour

Devils Thumb Ranch, Tabernash, CO

Sunday February 24

10K or 20K Classic or Freestyle

Race Start 10AM

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight lows Saturday around 11F; Cloudy Sunday with 50% chance of snow and highs around 35F. Expected race temps around 20-25F with fresh snow. Probable soft track conditions.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush out well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polishing with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen kick zone with 180 grit sandpaper, and iron in Base Wax Green. Cover with 2-3 layers of Carbon Blue, or Carbon Violet for more kick.

Structure: A universal structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork as the expense of durability.
