

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## 21<sup>st</sup> Owl Creek Chase

Aspen to Snowmass, CO

Saturday February 9

25K/15K Freestyle

Race Start 9AM Elite, 10AM Citizens 15K/Tour

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday:** Snow likely. Breezy. Snow accumulation 1 to 3 inches. Highs 15 to 25. West winds 15 to 25 mph. Chance of snow 70 percent. **Friday Night:** Mostly cloudy with a 30 percent chance of snow. Lows zero to 10 above. West winds 10 to 20 mph with gusts to around 35 mph. **Saturday:** Partly cloudy. Highs near 35. Lows zero to 10 below

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, brushing with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and finally, polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine structure will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (Helix, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
