Forecast/Conditions: We expect fresh packed powder.

Saturday evening temperature is expected to dip into the low teens from the high teens, with race time temperature around 14. Expect mostly sunny skies.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
