

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Valley Spur Ski Trails, Munising, MI

Saturday, January 10

10 A.M. Mass Start

12/24K Classic (1/2 laps), 24K Skate (2 laps)

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low near 9, remaining steady until start time. Race time temperatures in the 10-15 degree range with gusty winds, overcast skies and chance of snow. Expect new snow overnight to be machine worked and packed, and tracks to become lightly glazed.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. Iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, smooth with cork, let cool. Apply 2-3 layers of Carbon GripWax White. Those wanting more kick should apply a shorter layer of Carbon Blue.

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool before JetStream application, will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
