

WAX RECOMMENDATION

26K/42K Skate

10 A.M. Mass start on Lake Hayward

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a firm machine worked track after large temperature fluctuations during the week. Temperatures Friday night are expected to be in the low 20s with a small chance of snow/freezing rain. Race time temperatures will be in the mid-20s.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal stone grind will best suit these conditions. Or one pass with the coarse-offset wheel followed by one pass of the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
