

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Boulder Lake Ski Race**

Boulder Lake Mgmt Trails

18 miles north of Duluth, MN

Sunday, January 11

11 A.M.

Wave start, 3 waves starting 2 minutes apart

10.3K/31K Skate

Forecast/Conditions: There is a chance of snow in the days leading up to this race. Existing base is solid. Expect temperatures to drop to the negative mid-single digits Saturday evening and rise to near mid-single digits by 11 A.M. Sunday.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly/LF Blue mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue (those skiing the 31K race should iron in the JetStream Blue), brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad. Skiers who have not hardened their bases recently by using Toko Blue or Nordlite Powder X-cold should start with a layer of LF Blue before proceeding with the LF Moly/LF Blue layer.

Structure: A cold or fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool before the HF Blue application, will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
