

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## **Como Championships**

Como Park, St. Paul, MN

Saturday, December 27

10K freestyle and High School 5K freestyle

9 A.M. start

Separate mass starts for men, women and high school  
5K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Friday temperatures should peak above 32F, dropping to a low in the mid 20s Friday night. Expect race temperatures in the mid 20s. There is chance of rain Friday night, changing to a chance of snow Saturday morning. Snow will be wind blown, with a 15-20 mph wind across the golf course.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

**Racing - Service**

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
