

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Hormel Nature Center Ski Race

Austin, MN

Sunday, February 1

9:30 A.M., 13K Classic

10:30 A.M., 13K Skate

Mass start, 2 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a firmly packed course with good snow coverage of transformed snow. Fairly flat course with much on the edge of the woods. Overnight low in the mid teens, start of race temperature in the mid 20s.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape & brush, then apply HF Red, scrape & brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush polish with thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Apply several coats of Carbon GripWax viola, corking between layers. If track is glazing, cover with one layer of Carbon Yellow.

Structure: Univerasal grind covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
