

WAX RECOMMENDATION



MN High School Championship

Giant's Ridge, Biwabik, MN

Friday, February 13

Pursuit race: 5K Classic and 5K Skate

Classic: 10 A.M. girls, 11 A.M. boys

Skate: 1:30 P.M. girls, 2:30 P.M. boys

Forecast/Conditions: Expect transformed granular snow. Thursday evening low 17. Temps during morning races in the low 20s. Temps during the afternoon races in mid-20s. Mostly cloudy and breezy.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-3 layers of Carbon GripWax Blue, corking between layers. Later starters or those desiring more kick should use Carbon Viola. When tracks glaze, Carbon Yellow will work well.

Structure: Universal grind covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
