



WAX RECOMMENDATION

Mora Vasaloppet

Mora, MN

Sunday, February 8

9 A.M., 42K Classic

10 A.M., 35K/58K Skate

12:30 P.M., 13K Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Expect excellent conditions with hard packed transformed snow and firm and durable classic tracks.

Saturday night low of 11, warming to mid-teens for start of Classic race, longer Skate races in high-teens, late Skate race mid-20s.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. For Classic, apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Rotocork JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. For 10 A.M. race use HF Red followed by JetStream Red. For 12:30 P.M. race use HF Red/HF Yellow mixed 1:1 followed by JetStream Yellow.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Carbon BaseWax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Skiers at the front should start with several layers of Carbon GripWax Blue covered with Carbon White, corking between layers. For those desiring more kick use Carbon Blue for all layers. Further back in the pack Carbon Yellow will be good for glazed tracks.

Structure: Universal or fine grind covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
