## Soaring Eagle New Years Challenge

Soaring Eagle Trails near Park Rapids, MN

Sunday, December 28

Noon start

7.5K and 18K freestyle races

Forecast/Conditions: Chance of snow on Saturday with Saturday evening low near zero F. Expect temperatures at race time in the low teens.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush very well. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush, and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
