

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

CXC Skiing SuperTour at Telemark

Telemark Lodge, Cable, WI

Sunday, February 1

9:30 A.M., Men 15K Skate, mass start, 2 laps

10:45 A.M., Women 10K Skate, mass start, 2 laps

11:45 A.M., Male J2/HS/Citizen 5K Skate, mass start

12:15 P.M., Female J2/HS/Citizen 5K Skate, mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low around 15, near 20 for the Men's and Women's races and 25 for the latest starters. Slight chance of snow during the races. Expect a machine worked, packed powder trail.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush. Women and Men starters then apply HF Blue/HF Red mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. Latest racers should substitute HF Red for Blue/Red mix and JetStream Red for JetStream Blue.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine linear structure, covered by 1-2 passes with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions. No additional structure may be required if snowing.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
