

# WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**<sup>®</sup>

## City of Lakes Loppet -- Skate

Wirth Park, Minneapolis, MN

Sunday, February 1

10:30 A.M.

33K Skate

6 waves of 200 skiers

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a variety of conditions. Course is hilly in the first two thirds, flat over the final third. Mostly transformed natural snow, but about 2K of man-made. Without new snow, expect leaves and twigs in the woods and dirt in other places. Expect tracks to deteriorate. Saturday evening low temp in the high teens. Race temp will start in near 20 and end in the low 20s. Partly cloudy and relatively calm.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: Universal grind covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
