

WAX RECOMMENDATION



City of Lakes Loppet Toko/Finn Sisu Sprints

Minneapolis, MN

Saturday, January 31

5 P.M.

1K Skate sprint

2.5 loops with four 180 degree turns

Forecast/Conditions: Course is mostly flat and on man-made snow. Saturday should be partly cloudy with the temperature rising steadily throughout the day to 32 degrees. Race temperature around 30.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the fine-linear wheel of a Toko structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
