Bearskin Wilderness Pursuit - Day Two

Bearskin Lodge, Gunflint Trail, Grand Marais, MN

Sunday, March 1

10 A.M.

10K Skate, pursuit start

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a firm base covered with a fresh layer of snow falling in Thursday at temperatures near 10. Saturday evening low near 0 with temperatures at the start of race near 5. Mostly sunny and breezy. Expect wind-blown snow on the lake.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, sprinkle on Nordlite Powder X-cold, iron in together, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: Cold grind or fine linear grind. No additional structure is required.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
