

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Fridtjof Nansen Ski Race

Tower Ridge Ski Area, Eau Claire, WI

Sunday, January 24

11 A.M.

4K/8K/15K Skate

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night low temperature around 34, steady until race time. Overcast with rain likely overnight and possible during the race. Expect softening conditions as the race progresses.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A warm universal grind or a universal grind covered by one pass with the Yellow TOKO Structurite tool (old coarse offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
