

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Hoigaards Slush Rush

Elm Creek Park Reserve, Maple Grove, MN

Saturday, March 6

8:45 A.M. 10K Skate

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a firm course with ice or a glaze, but soft around the edges. Also expect dirty snow. Saturday morning low of mid-20s at 4 A.M. rising to high 20s by race time. Partly cloudy, 20 percent chance of rain or freezing rain during the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red/HF Moly mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A universal grind covered by one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) followed by one pass of the Blue TOKO Structurite tool (old fine-linear wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
