

WAX RECOMMENDATION



City of Lakes Freestyle Loppet

Theo Wirth Park, Minneapolis, MN

Sunday, February 7

33K Skate

Race ends in the streets of Minneapolis Uptown area.

Six waves of 200 skiers

Forecast/Conditions: Expect the course to be in excellent shape. Snowfall is likely on Friday at temps from the mid-20s to 32. Unlike the classic course, this snowfall will not be tilled into the underlying chopped ice, but simply packed. Sunday morning low temperature in the mid-teens (around 8 A.M.), rising into the low 20s by race time. Overcast with a slight breeze and a 33 percent chance of snow during the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Red, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A fine linear grind covered by one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old fine-linear wheel) after the HF Red application will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
