

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## ABC Invitational Relays

Bunker Park Golf Course, Coon Rapids, MN

Saturday, January 12

4x3 relay, 2 legs classic and 2 legs skate

Boys Races starts at 10AM

Girls races start 11:30AM

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night**...Mostly cloudy. Low around 17. **Saturday**...Mostly cloudy with a chance of snow. Race time temperatures in the low twenties.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and, finally, brush with a Thermopad. HelX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with Toko Carbon Blue kick wax. Those wanting more kick could use Toko Carbon Viola, or Carbon Yellow if the tracks glaze.

Structure: A universal stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

Note: Race location could change to Chomonix or Trollhagen – please check with race sponsor.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HelX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
