

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Edgewood Winter Blast

Edgewood Golf Course, Fargo, ND

Saturday, January 12

5K classic - 5K and 10K skate races

Skate races start 9:30AM

Classic races start at 11AM

Interval starts - one lap

Forecast/Conditions: **Friday Night**...Mostly cloudy. Low near five. **Saturday**...Partly sunny. Race time temperatures in the upper single digits.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Moly, and polishing well with a dedicated nylon polishing brush. HeIX Cold would make an excellent alternative to JetStream.

Gripwax: Sand kick zone lightly with 150 grit sandpaper. Apply Toko Base Wax Green, heat and spread with a synthetic cork. Cover with Toko Carbon Mint kick wax. Those starting late or who desire more kick should use Carbon White.

Structure: A fine to a fine-linear stonegrind will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes available, skip the Fluorocarbon (HeIX, JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red, Blue). Additionally, for those who do not have a rotocork (for applying JetStream), this step can be replaced by vigorously corking with a dedicated Plasto Cork at the expense of durability.
